## GAMMA working meeting


A local project meeting organized by the GAMMA team from Osijek was held on June 30 and July 1, 2021, in the premises of the Department of Mathematics in Osijek. The GAMMA working meeting was attended by partners from Croatia, i.e. GAMMA team members from J. J. Strossmayer University of Osijek, the Department of Mathematics (MATHOS), Elektrotehnička i prometna škola Osijek, Srednja škola Markantuna de Dominisa Rab and the Education and Teacher Training Agency. This was the first project activity held live. During the meeting, participants




had effective discussions about scenario templates, the Croatian topics for scenarios, the MATHOS chapter of the handbook and educational games. A scenario template was elaborated, which was sent to other partners for review and discussion. A less formal part of the meeting was held in Baranja, where the participants had the opportunity to get to know each other better over dinner. The evaluation of the meeting showed that the exchange of ideas in the live meeting was very important, and this was a very fruitful and successful meeting.

## Presentation of the project

The project was presented in Croatia at the International Scientific Colloquium *Mathematics and Children* on May 29, 2021. The presenter was Ljerka Jukić Matić, assistant professor in the Department of Mathematics, University of Osijek.



**Prof.** Chronis Kynigos, the coordinator from the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, was a lecturer at the conference *PME 44: Mathematics Education in the 4<sup>th</sup> Industrial Revolution* held in Thailand. In his talk delivered on June 21, 2021, he presented the GAMMA project.
